Representative commercial spaces: *unless noted, most of the following are various types of applied painted finishes to walls and ceilings. Usually there was significant work to complete, reception areas, elevator lobbies, and corridors throughout. Occasionally I list details, but these were all major jobs. Painted custom finishes have classic appeal, look great and add elegance, wear well, and are more affordable than custom wallcovering. The projects involved meeting with architects, builders, and clients; reading plans, and pricing based on square footage, access, time frame, and amount of detail. Then creating samples for approval. Timing installation with other trades, which often meant flexible scheduling. Hiring assistants, loading equipment, and completing work efficiently and neatly. Oftentimes I was the last trade in the space, after carpet and flooring install. Then, be able to duplicate finish for future remodels and touching up. I am forever grateful and indebted to the designers, architectural firms, and clients who trusted in me to make their spaces look fabulous! I think of you often*
